


### **CSI Vision**



#### 6.1.5 Base data set governance

The role of a base data set coordinator is hereby established to encourage base data governance. It is the responsibility of a base data set coordinator to ensure that the base spatial data custodian and the base attribute data custodian create base data sets that adhere to all policies, standards and specifications. The base data set coordinator will also be responsible for ensuring data compatibility and integration of base date sets of different base data set custodianship for the same base data sets but with adjoining

### **Purpose of the Workshop**

convene key stakeholders in Journ Annual
geodetic community to:

- Strengthen national coordination of geodetic infrastructure, data, skills, and services.
- Raise awareness of the UN-GGRF resolution and align South Africa's strategies with global best practice.
- Identify national priorities and gaps in geodetic capacity, governance, and investment.
- Establish the National Geodesy Working Group (NGWG) as a formal mechanism for coordination and representation.

#### 6.1.2 Cooperation and coordination

(a) Due to the limited resources available to the country, many government departments are currently experiencing budget constraints. Base data set custodians will commit to promoting efficient, economic and effective use of resources by cooperating and coordinating with each other in sharing data and information, as enshrined in the Constitution, 1996 [section 195 (1)(b)]. All base data set custodians and agents will commit to proper maintenance, improved accessibility and fair distribution of base data sets. Base data set custodians will work together to facilitate data and information sharing in order to avoid duplication of base data set capture and costs to all spheres of government. Base data set custodians should, where possible, consult users in line with Batho Pele principles in determining needs when capturing or updating spatial information.

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- Improve access to base data sets through capture and publication of metadata; and
- Institutionalize base data sets governance.



### Recommendations

- Reports on the activities of the National Geodesy Working Group must be compiled on a regular basis and submitted to the Committee for Spatial Information (CSI) through the Subcommittee on Technology.
- These reports should highlight progress, challenges, recommendations, and opportunities for collaboration, ensuring transparency, accountability, and alignment with the objectives of the South African Spatial Data Infrastructure (SASDI).
